Sunday, June 10, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

For those taking care of a father or grandfather who is sick, elderly, disabled or frail, we pray to the Lord.

Day: Is 49:1-6/Acts 13:22-26/Lk 1:57-66, 80
